The Department of Pathology at the Medical College of Georgia invites applications at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor for an individual with strong diagnostic skills for a full time faculty position in the Section of Anatomic Pathology. Expertise in diagnostic pathology is required. Fellowship training and/or experience in signing out renal pathology cases, particularly transplant biopsies, is highly desired, including experience with interpretation of immunofluorescence and electron microscopy findings. The successful candidate will also participate in general surgical pathology service so other subspecialty interests or certifications are desirable. This individual will be involved in resident and medical student teaching.

Applicants should have an MD degree or equivalent, and be board certified or board eligible in Anatomic Pathology. Georgia license or eligibility for licensure to practice medicine in Georgia is required. Applicants should have experience in diagnostic pathology and a record of academic productivity. Prior administrative experience and oversight of an active renal pathology program will be an advantage.

There are active adult and pediatric nephrology services and a renal transplant program. The Pathology Department receives approximately 150 adult and pediatric renal biopsies a year, two-thirds being transplant biopsies. In addition, the Department is actively involved in the dynamic growth of innovative oncology programs supported by the Georgia Cancer Coalition that include participation in a statewide clinical trials program and leadership of a state-wide tumor tissue and serum bio-repository. The Department offers a strong supportive environment that is closely linked to successful centers in Molecular Immunology/Immunotherapy, Vascular Biology, and Biotechnology & Genomic Medicine.

Appointments will be at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor and salary will be based upon level of qualification, experience, and scholarly accomplishments. The institution offers a generous fringe benefit package and a productivity-based incentive plan.
