



Lihong Bu, M.D., Ph.D.

I am an Associate Professor of Laboratory Medicine and Pathology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. I have an M.D. degree from China Medical University and Ph.D. degree from Brigham Young University. I completed residency in Anatomic Pathology at UT Southwestern followed by a fellowship in Renal Pathology at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. I worked as a renal pathologist and established the Electron Microscopy Laboratory at the University of Minnesota before joining Mayo Clinic Rochester in 2021.

I have been involved in the Renal Pathology Society (RPS) for the past nine years and served on Communications and Website Committee, Pre-analytic and Analytic EM Variation Working Group, and Financial and Fundraising Committee. As the chair of the Financial and Fundraising Committee, I directly collaborated with the Treasurer, Education and Training committee, Secretary, and President and during the application of the industry sponsored grant and the corporate sponsorship. In my role as Financial and Fundraising Committee chair, I helped with the Digital Pathology Room at ASN Kidney Week 2023 sponsored by Novartis, RPS Satellite Meeting during the USCAP 2024 sponsored by Alnylam, and developed guidelines for RPS corporate sponsorship. Also serving on the RPS Board of Advisors made me knowledgeable about the RPS functions.

I am a participating renal pathologist in the NEPTUNE study, and I have research interests in IgA nephropathy, lupus nephritis, kidney diseases related to monoclonal gammopathy, and renal transplant pathology.
